Membership Requirements and Benefits

1. Member

Members of the Guild are artisans who have achieved a high standard of excellence in a their trade, and who have been professionally active in the building-related arts for at least five years. Members are skilled in the preservation, restoration, and appropriate recreation of period artisan work, and dedicated to the continuance of their craft.

Member Benefits include:

- full "brochure" on website with links and multiple images
- inclusion in all meetings and events
- voting privileges
- networking and mentoring opportunities
- respect of other members and the community at large.

Member Responsibilities:

Members pay yearly dues of \$150 paid on or before January 30 of each year, and participate actively with one or more of the following:

- attend monthly meetings at least 3 times per year
- Host a meeting
- Present lecture or slideshow for other members or to the public
- Submit content for our blog, social networking, or other publicity outlets
- Participate on a committee

1a. Company Membership: This option is available for businesses with two or more principals, who vote and participate as one entity. The dues for Company Members are \$200 per year.

2. Associates

With the above guidelines in mind, Associate membership includes: Individuals who do not yet qualify for membership but might in the future i.e. apprentices, new businesses; those in related businesses and building trades; less active members, or those living outside of the San Francisco Bay Area.

Artisans interested Membership are encouraged to participate as Associate Members for at least one year prior to presenting, to streamline this process.

Associates: Associate Membership is granted by invitation of the Membership Committee. Prior to applying, prospective Associates should attend at least one meeting to meet other members.
